Confirmations 2025

Bishop Patrick will be visiting our Parish on Saturday 28th June to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for the young people of the Parishes of SS Peter & Paul, St Hugh's and Our Lady of Lincoln.

The preparation sessions for those who have applied to receive this Sacrament will commence on Thursday 23rd January in the Parish at 7.00pm. All candidates are requested to arrive no later than 6.50pm that evening, so that we can make a prompt start. This will be an introductory session and full details of further sessions and requirements of Candidates will be given during this session.

Hospital Admission: If you or a member of your family are admitted to hospital, the parish clergy are not automatically informed. If you wish to receive visits from a chaplain and/or receive any of the sacraments whilst in hospital, please let us know. Alternatively ask a member of the ward staff to contact the hospital chaplaincy team and they will arrange it. The chaplaincy team also hold the rota of priests available for administering the Sacrament of the Sick in emergencies at night.

Mass Time Change: Please note due to a funeral in the parish on Friday 10th January there is no exposition, confessions or Noon Mass on that day.

Second Collection to be taken at all Masses over the weekend of 11th and 12th January for the Sick and Retired Priests Fund: Donations to this fund are to provide a sum for the priests of the Diocese who are currently in service so that an annual grant can be paid to them when they retire. The fund is also used to support priests if they are sick and unable to work for any reason.

School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies (Reception class) - children born between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021: The deadline for submitting applications for a school place is 15th January. Application forms are available on 'home' Local Authority websites. For every Catholic school application where a child is to be considered and ranked under

a faith criterion there should also be a supplementary information form, completed and returned to the school by the deadline; these forms are available from the LA and the school. Applicants must also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, e.g. baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable; contact the parish of baptism for a copy if needed, in good time). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean the child is ranked in a lower criterion, which may affect chances of a place.
